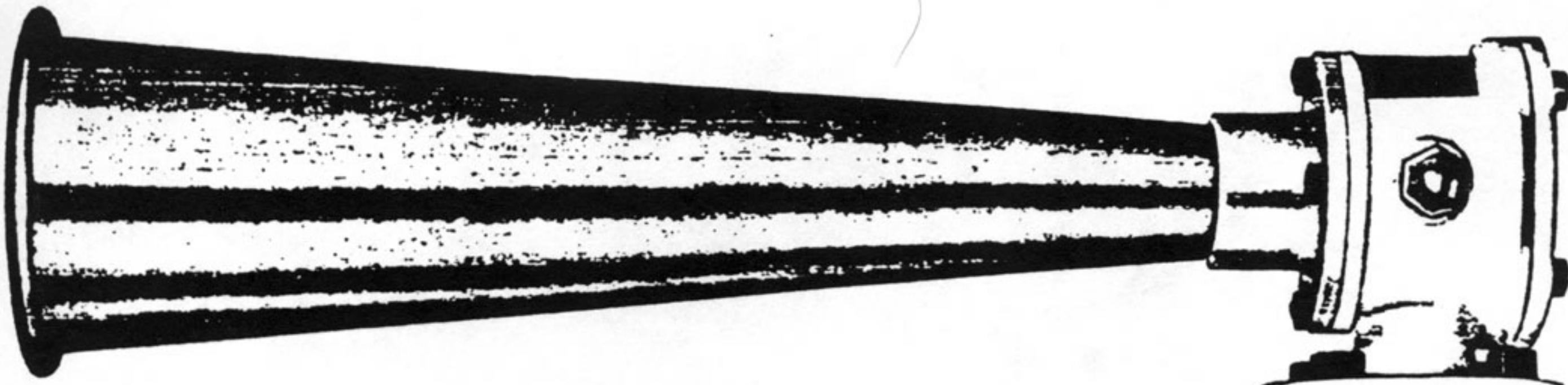


PUBLIC ALARM EQUIPMENT



THE DIAPHONE

The Diaphone Horn operated by compressed air is the distinctive feature of Gamewell public alarm systems and is the most powerful and efficient sound producing device yet developed for fire alarm purposes. The Diaphone is characterized by great carrying power, distinctive and unmistakable tone, and the ability to sound coded signals in short, clear, and distinct blasts.

Reserve capacity is of vital importance in emergency signaling services. Any means employed for the purpose of announcing the existence and location of fire or other emergency is inadequate and inherently unreliable if not continuously capable of performing its function irrespective of power failure or other cause.

Diaphone compressed air alarm outfits are self-contained units providing, by means of automatically controlled motor compressors, an adequate reserve supply of compressed air for alarm purposes. The air is stored in suitable reservoirs and power for operating the motor compressors is obtained from the local electric light or commercial power supply.
